## Introduction


Super HUD displays statistics information from [Hold'em Profiler](#) (Poker Tracking Software) and [Top Shark Pro](#) (Tournament Rankings Software) **right on the poker table**. It creates a unified display platform for linking all of the information that players need as they play. It gives you the information you want, when you want it.

Super HUD has over 70 statistics that can be displayed including VP\$IP, Pre Flop Raise %, Aggression Factor, ITM, Mucked Cards, Player Type , player rankings, ROI, and so much more. It even displays stats for Folded to Continuation, Attempted to steal, and 4Bet Pre-flop.

Super HUD is free to all existing customers; just use your existing login informant for [Hold'em Profiler](#) or [Top Shark Pro](#) to activate the software.

## Getting Started

After completing the download process, the home page for Super HUD will display. Information both your Hold'em Profiler and/Top shark Pro accounts will display.

Super HUD configuration is accessible by clicking on the tab at the top of the screen.

- **HUD Profiles** - Create and save multiple profiles based on group and statistic settings you select
- **HUD Options** – Set up options for profiles, filters and more
- **Auto Import** – Setup automatic hand history import from the 3 supported websites: Poker Stars, Full Tilt and iPoker Network
- **Manual Import** – Manually import hand history files from your local drive, Poker Tracker or Hold'em Manager
- **Active Tables** – When playing online, Super HUD can provide player statistics under each player at the table. If you access Super HUD while playing online, all tables you are playing will display here. You can select which of the active tables to wish to have display player statistics.

When you are done with the setup process – the next time you play poker, your table view will display like this (depending on your settings).



# HUD Profiles tab

Use this tab to create and save unlimited profiles. To start, click on **New Profile**.



## Add Groups


Click on **Add Group** to start.

After your new group displays – customize **Group Settings**:


1. Rename the group
2. Select the information to show as a grid or popup
3. Enter a separator symbol, such as / - this will display in between each statistic you select to show
4. Change the padding option from 0 to 1 – this will add spaces between each statistics (easier to read).





If you elected to have your group display as a popup, complete the **Popup Groups** settings:

After creating your group, click on the **Add** button and select from the dropdown list. You can add each group and define different statistics for each as desired. The statistics that display during online play will then be different for each phase of the hand.







  - a. Click on the **Edit** button to view color choices




Continue setting up your profile by selecting the statistics you want to display when you are playing poker. Use the plus signs to expand each group available statistics.

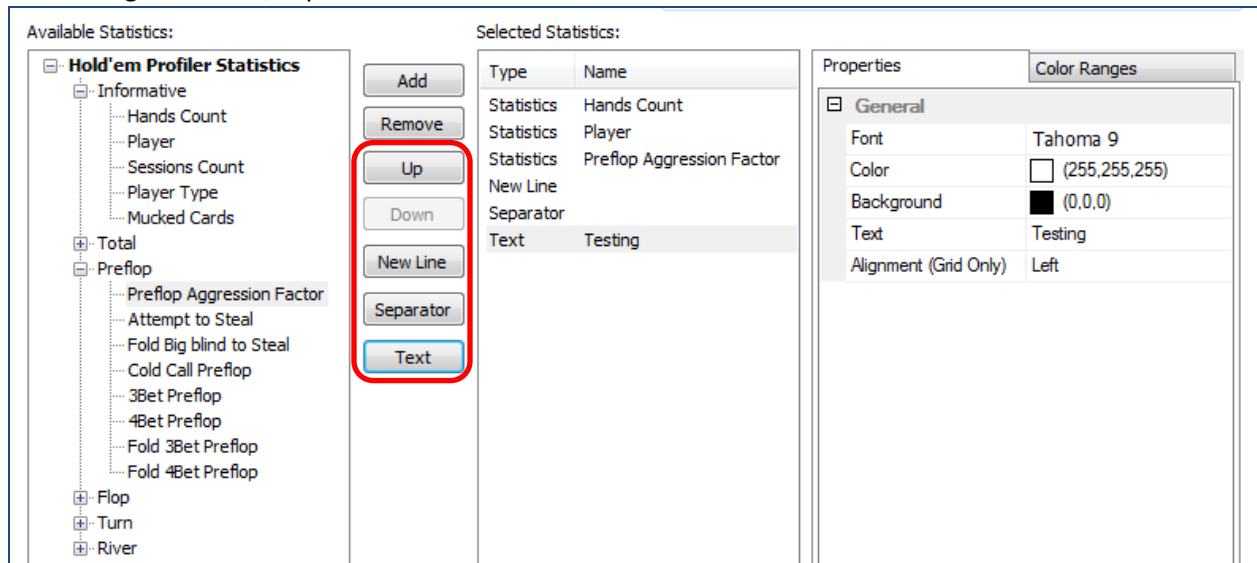

Further define the statistics to display, by:

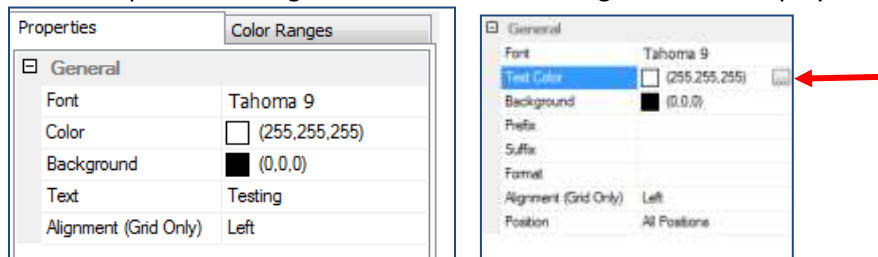
- Changing the order of the selected statistics (click on the statistic you wish to move and then the **Up** or **Down** button)
- Adding a new line, separator or text as desired



Each selected statistic can be formatted using the options shown here:

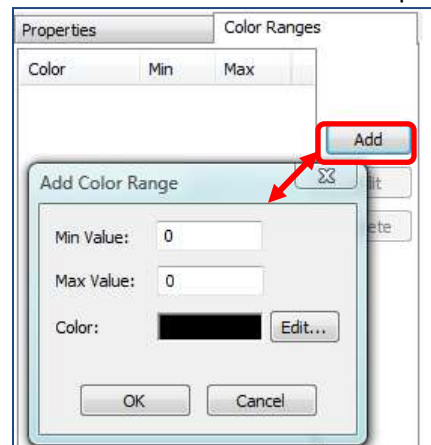


Click the **Add** button to set color preferences



## HUD Options

Create settings for:

1. Default profiles – Select one of the profiles created on the HUD profiles tab from the dropdown list
2. Default filters – Select one of the filters created in Hold'em Profiler or Top Shark Pro from the dropdown list
3. Mucked Card view – Use the arrows to select the # of seconds you wish to have the muck cards viewable when playing
4. Tournament filters – Select Tournament Type and Filter from the dropdown list. Choices are pulled from what you have created in Hold'em Profiler or Top Shark Pro
5. Table themes – Select a table theme from one of the supported poker sites





## Auto Import

Setup automatic import of your hand history files from the three supported websites. The first step in the process is to make sure that your hand history files are being saved on the site you use to play poker.


Super HUD provides a link to the steps to follow for each supported site – just click on the site name and then on the link that displays.





## Manual Import

Select Import from Poker Tracker or Hold'em Manager to locate hand history files stored on the online tool. To complete the import, complete the database settings as shown below. Click the **Start Import** button to begin the file transfer.

When you install Poker Tracker or Hold'em Manager, you can specify these settings. If you are not sure if your settings are correct, contact the appropriate company and they should be able to help you. If you leave the settings at the default, this process should work fine.
